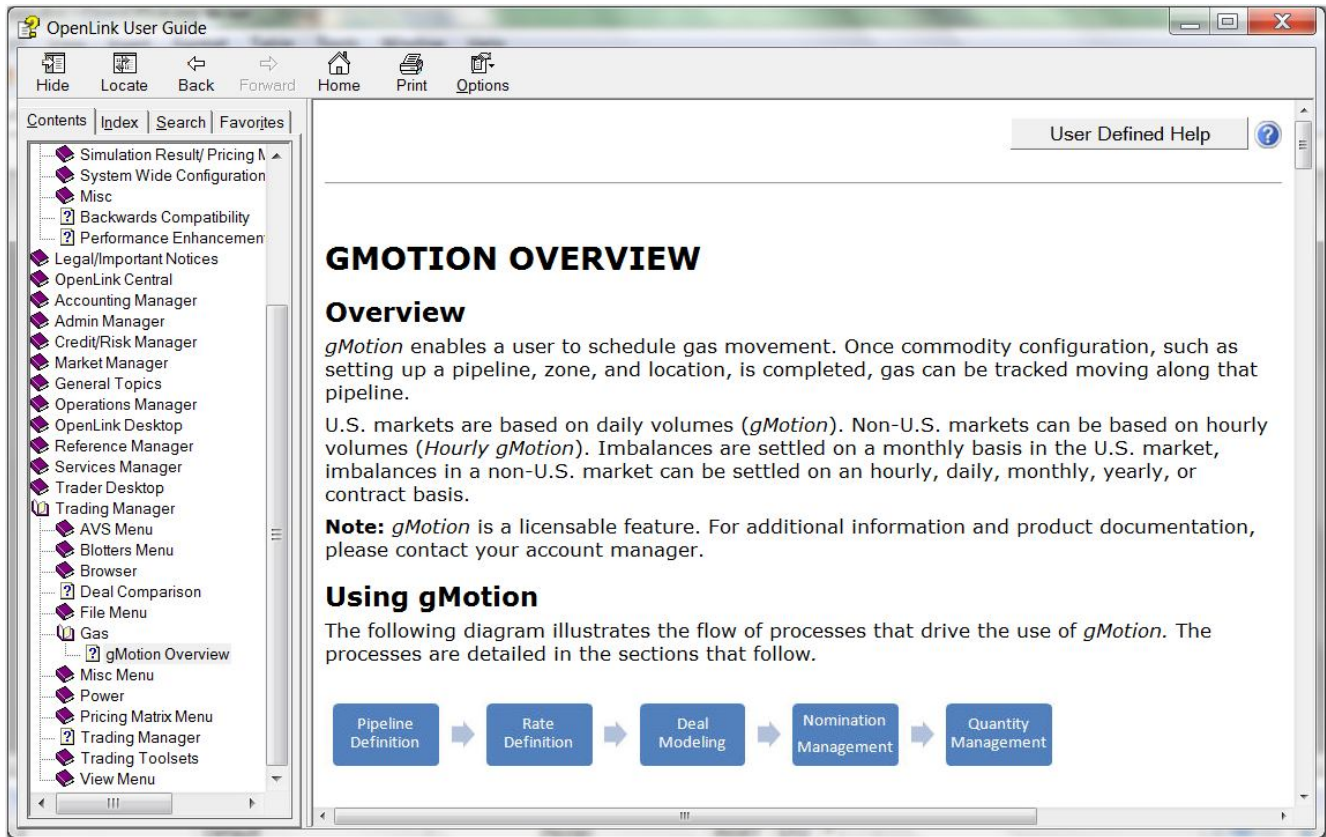

Pipeline Definition

Pipelines refer to the service providers used to transport commodities from one location to another. Within the context of *gMotion*, pipelines transport natural gas from one location to another. Locations can be points of receipt (where gas leaves from) or points of delivery (the destination of the gas), or both (i.e., bidirectional).

The term On-System refers to a pipeline that is owned and operated by the company running *gMotion*. The term Off-System pipeline refers to pipelines owned and operated by external entities that act as service providers to the company who is running *gMotion*.
